

#### Ladies

- Only dyes or highlights of natural tones will be allowed.

- Well combed, with hair cut and length appropriately
- No dyes or highlights of any shade are allowed.
- They must attend properly shaved (no beard, no moustaches).

### Use of electronics

- If you bring your cell phone to school, it must be handed in within the first hour of class. (Cell phones will be picked up and stored in a locked box. They will be delivered at the end of the day.)
- The student will not be able to make use of their cell phone and/or electronic devices to call, chat, create videos or take photos.
- The use of tablets, iPads, computers and headphones/airpods is authorized only to be used in class periods where they are required with the supervision of the teachers of the subject. Each student must remember to bring the appropriate chargers for their electronic equipment.
- Students/parents are responsible for the security, transportation, and warranties of their devices. (El Colegio de Panama is not responsible for loss or damage to devices.)
- It is the responsibility of students to keep their devices safe.
- Devices should not be left unattended
- If an unattended device is found, it will be sent to the administration offices.
- Students are not allowed to bring e-cigarettes, cigarettes, vapes, psychoactive substances, sharp objects or weapons of any kind to school. Students who are caught with any of these articles will be sanctioned accordingly according to our internal regulations.

### **Bullying** policies


